Helping Your Brother in Need: Crates for Ukraine Update—

In all, the OPC delivered an amazing 307 crates to Dallas and Chattanooga as part of Mission to the World's Crates for Ukraine Winter Edition. Seventy-two OPC Churches from 16 presbyteries in 24 states participated! MTW L'viv team leader, Doug Shepherd, is hugely grateful for the OPC's participation in the effort, and says we are "punching way above our weight class." Conservative estimates for the overall CFU Winter effort came in at over 800 crates! Praise the Lord for the connected church and for His work during this horrific time.

Turkey Earthquake Fund Update—

To date we've collected \$112,507 in donations! Thanks to all those who have given! Recently OPC Disaster Response agreed to send \$20,000. of those funds to one of our ministry partners in the region and is considering other avenues where these funds may minister while sharing the gospel. The fund continues to be open to accept donations. Please continue to pray for Reformed pastors and missionaries in the region.
